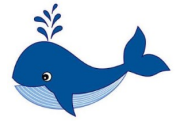




Class Whale's Learning Journey

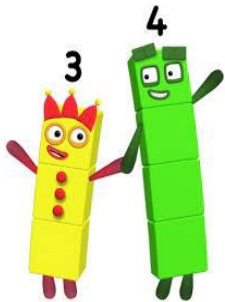
Autumn 1 Week 4

c k



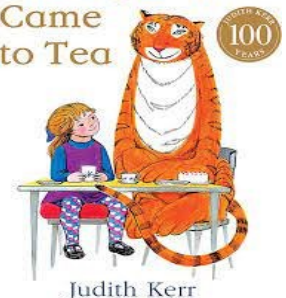
Our maths focus this week has been the composition of 3 and 4. We have also been learning about spatial awareness and positional language.
