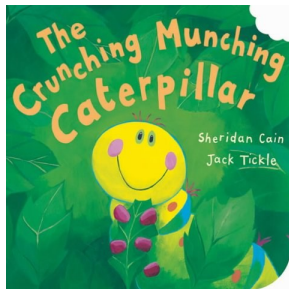
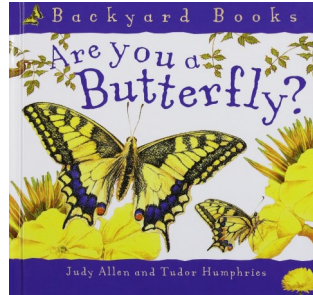
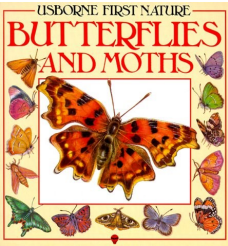
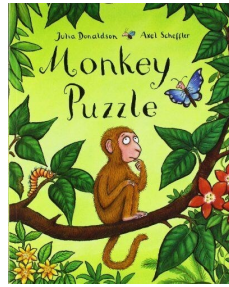
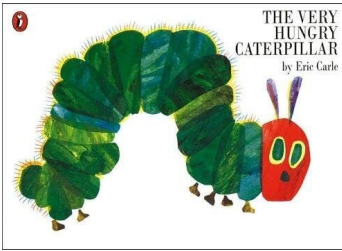


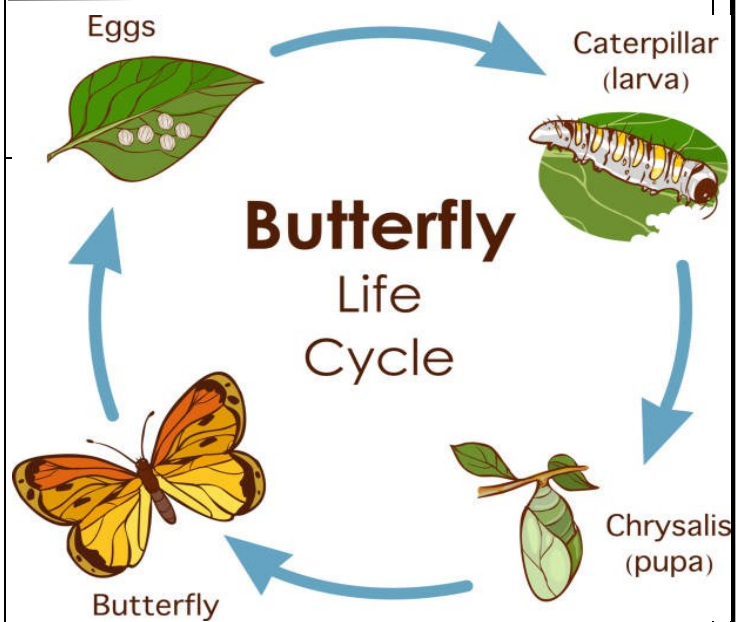


FS2 Knowledge Organiser- Caterpillars and Butterflies- Life Cycles

The "Meadow Brown" is the most common Butterfly in England. Their wings are about 5cm wide. They live for 2 weeks.



Butterfly Facts::

Caterpillars have 12 eyes

After a caterpillar hatches it will eat their egg.

Butterflies wings are symmetrical. This means that both sides are exactly the same.

Butterflies taste with their feet.

Butterflies tend to live for around 2-4 weeks after they come out of their chrysalis.

Butterflies love to drink from muddy puddles.

Butterflies can't fly if they get too cold.



Things to do at home:

-Go on a nature walk to find butterflies.

-Make a pair of butterfly wings.

-Use pipe cleaners and a stick to make a caterpillar!
