Expressive Art and Design:

- •Designing and creating art around our topic work. Understanding the World:

- •We will be exploring WINTER and the Poles on our planet.
- We will look at Polar animals and geography in the Arctic regions
- •We will look at environmental issues at home and in the Polar regions.
- We will learn about Chinese New Year Celebrations!

Phonics:

Physical Development:

- Fundamental Movement Skills Gymnastics in PE (Balance Floor Work)
- Handwriting: number and letter formation. (In phonics and maths)
- Fine motor skills scissors, crafting, colouring
- •Learning to zip our own coats.







Personal, Social & Emotional:

- Children will continue to show an understanding of their own feelings and those of others.
- •Children will learn that they are part of a larger community. They will learn that their small actions can have a big impact.
- As the work load increases in the Spring Term, children will start to demonstrate perseverance and pride in their work.

Communication, Language & Literacy:

- Developing Vocabulary based on our weekly topics: <u>Winter and the Arctic Regions</u>, <u>Environmental Issues and Chinese New Year</u>.
- •Children will be encouraged to articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences. Children will be writing short sentences about our topic work.
- "Talk Through Stories" is a reading programme that we use to foster a love of stories and story language. Children develop a deep familiarity with the texts. This term we will be reading: Elmer, I'm in Charge, Lost and Found, Where the Wild Things Are and Billy and the Dragon.

Maths: Activities are differentiated dependent on previous experiences and understanding:

- Representing numbers to 8
- Comparing numbers/quantities to 8.
- Composition of numbers to 8.
- Making pairs.
- Combining 2 groups.
- Addition by counting on.
- •Money- begin to recognise the value of different denominations of coins and notes (continued throughout the year in role play).
- Use everyday language to talk about position.
- Spatial reasoning select, rotate & manipulate shapes.

<u>At home:</u> Play family board games and card games. (Including dominoes.) Counting money and playing shop.
