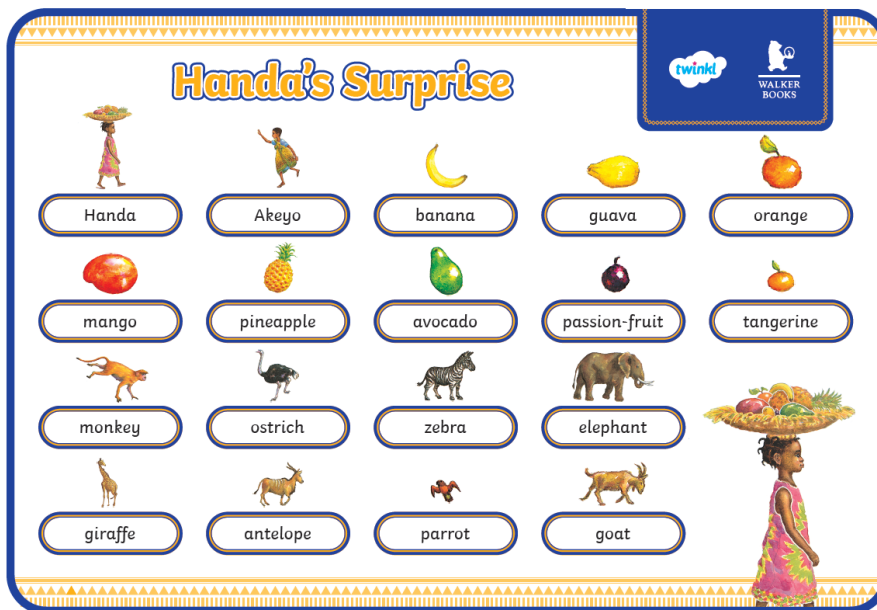
Lots of fruits need to grow in hot countries. Fruits come from all over the world!
