Text in bold are specific end points based on focussed UtW topics.	
End of FS1 (June)	 Talks about their own life story and some of the ways they have changed. Talks about how things grow and change over time. Has and uses developing vocabulary associated with the passing of time (e.g. last year, yesterday, tomorrow, next week). To talk about how they have changed from starting Nursery to transitioning to school.
Spring term (March)	 Remembers and talks about significant events in their own experience—including more details. Uses the language of time with adult modelling/encouragement. Begins to describe a sequence of events using words, such as 'first', 'then' Understands and uses a wider range of past tense verbs. To plant a seed and watch it grow- caring for it and talking about how it changes over time.
Autumn term (December)	 Remembers and talks about significant events in their own experience. Anticipates times of the day such as snack time and home time. Understands and uses some simple past tense verbs correctly. To recognise that they were once a baby and talk about how they have physically changed. To talk about how they changed from when they were born to their 1st birthday and their most recent birthday (physically & in relation to interests).
Baseline FS1 (September)	 Able to look at a before & after picture and say what has happened in between e.g. girl wit ice cream, ice cream on the floor. Attempts to use some simple past tense verbs.
