Reproduction	(Biology) To produce one or more offspring / young / babies.
Vagina	The female reproductive organ.
Penis.	The male reproductive organ.
Puberty	The time at which adolescents reach reproductive maturity.
Adalescent	A young person in the process of developing from a child to an adult.
Emotion	A strong feeling arising from your circumstances, mood, or relationships with others.
Harmanes.	A chemical in your body that can change and influence your mood or emotions.
Gender	The two sexes (male and female); in the 21 st century, gender is related to social and cultural differences rather than biological
ones.
