- ♦ The Victorians changed for the beach inside wooden carriages which were drawn into the sea by horses.

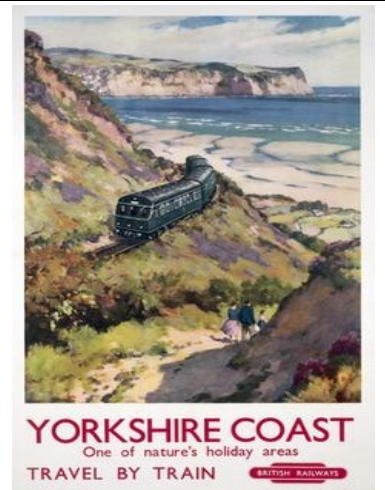


Things to do at home:
