#### I – Infer

Thinking of ideas or conclusions based on what has been read.

## What does the skill infer look like in Foundation Stage?

They demonstrate an understanding when talking with others about what they have read.





#### What does the skill infer look like in Key Stage One?

Asks and answers questions and makes inferences on the basis of what is being said and done.

## What does the skill infer look like in Lower Key Stage Two?

Can use inference and deduction skills to discuss messages, moods, feelings and attitudes using clues from the text. Can understand and explain different characters' points of view. Can identify the relationships between characters, explaining the effects this has on the reader e.g. how the characters behave in different ways as they interact with different people and/or different setting.

## What does the skill infer look like in Upper Key Stage Two?

Can infer, deduce and evaluate how messages, mood, feelings and attitudes are conveyed in poetry, prose and non-fiction making reference to the text. Can evaluate relationships between characters and how they behave in different ways. Can confidently identify and explain different characters' points of view and how this impacts on the reader. Can discuss how inferences may differ depending on the experiences of the reader.
