P – Predict

Thinking of what events could happen next based on what has been read.

What does the skill predict look like in Foundation Stage?

Children are starting to sequence simple stories that they have read and then make simple predictions about events in the story. Uses front cover, book title, illustrations and blurb to make predictions about the content of the text.



What does the skill predict look like in Key Stage One?

Can make sensible, plausible predictions about a text using a range of clues, based on what they have read. Can use the front cover and book title, illustrations and blurb to make predictions about the content of the text.



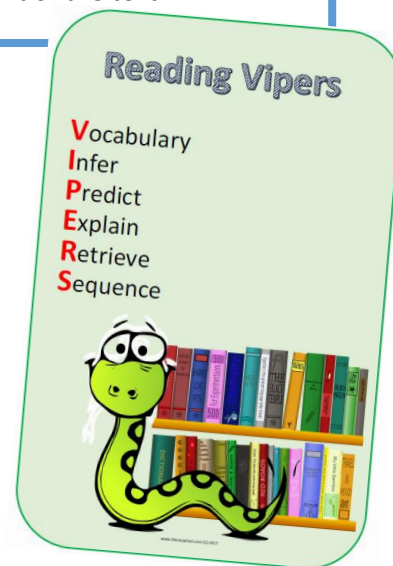
What does the skill predict look like in Lower Key Stage Two?

When prompted can justify and elaborate on opinions and predictions referring back to the text for evidence. Can refer to the text to support opinions and predictions.



What does the skill predict look like in Upper Key Stage Two?

Participate in discussions about books and explain understanding about what has been read. Can refer to the text to support opinions and predictions.
