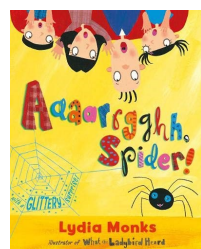
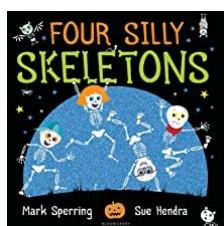
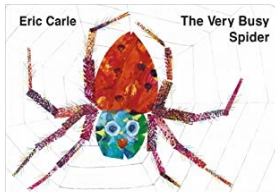
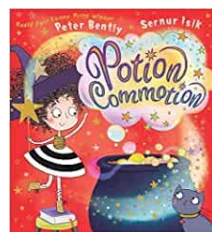
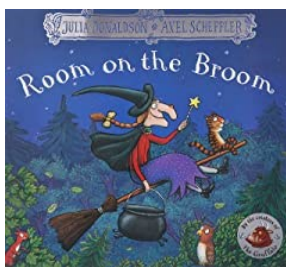
Autumn	A season in which the weather gets cooler and it gets darker earlier. Many leaves die and fall off the trees.
