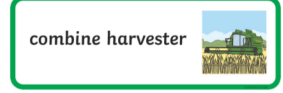


# FSI Knowledge Organiser- The Farm

- Match adult and baby animals.



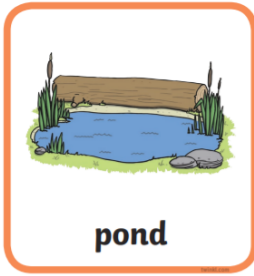
## We will:
