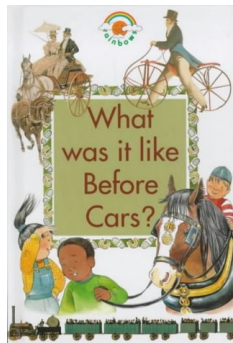
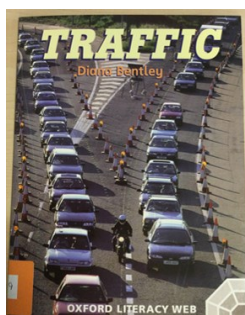
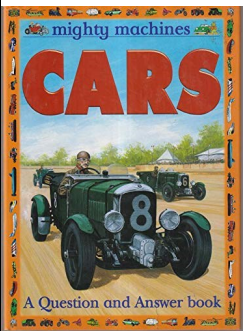
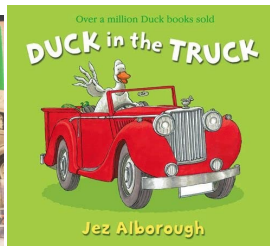
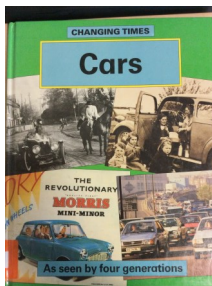
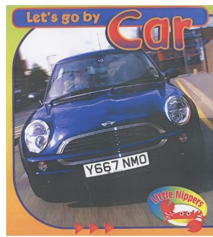
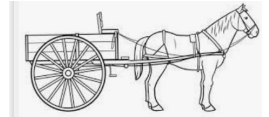


Books we will be reading:

There are many different types of cars. (Jeep, sports car, van, etc)

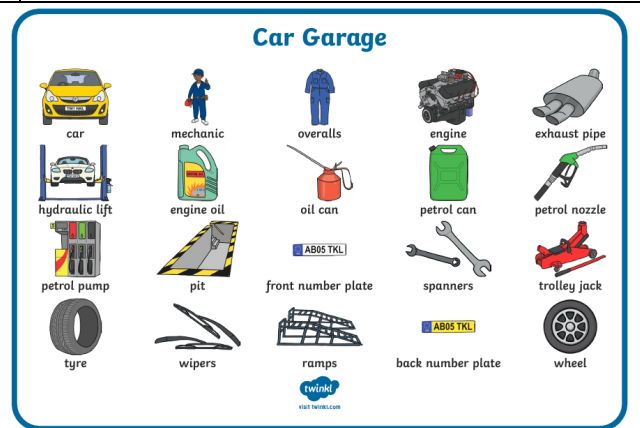
Most cars need petrol to go, but now many cars go on electricity.
