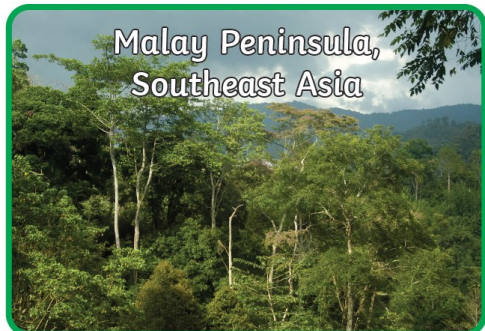
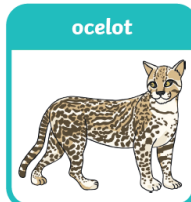
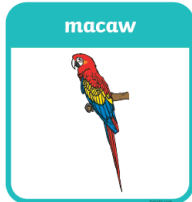


FSI Knowledge Organiser- Rainforest and Butterly

Rainforests are thick forests full of tall trees. They can be found near the sea or covering mountains.



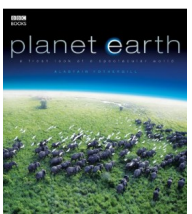
Rainforests can be warm with lots of rain. They can be found across the world.

Butterfly Facts

A butterfly is an insect because it has six legs.

Butterflies have two eyes but they never close them because they have no eyelids.

Butterflies drink nectar from flowers and juice from fruit using their proboscis, which is a bit like a tongue.

Can you see my proboscis? When I am not using it I roll it up out of the way.

There are over 17,000 species of butterfly in the world. In the UK there are over 50 species of butterfly and up to 22 of these can be spotted in gardens. Here are some of the ones you may see.

Parts of a Butterfly

Can you name any parts of the butterfly?

- antenna**
- head**
- thorax**
- forewing**
- abdomen**
- hindwing**

antenna
They are used to help them balance and smell.

abdomen
This holds all of the vital organs that a butterfly needs to survive.

hindwing
They have two hindwings.

forewing
They have two forewings.

head
They have two eyes, two antenna and a proboscis. They don't have noses and they use their feet to taste.

thorax
The four wings and six legs are attached to the thorax.

A life cycle is a series of changes that happen to all living things. Look how some of my friends grow and change.

How Long Does a Butterfly Live?

The average butterfly only lives for about one month.

Some butterflies only live up to a week.

The monarch butterfly has a longer lifespan of up to nine months.

Where Do Butterflies Live?

Can you think of any places that you have seen butterflies?

Different types of butterflies like to live in different places and they can be found in all types of **habitats**, such as forests, deserts, mountains, gardens and wetlands. The only place you won't find them is Antarctica.

Some people use pesticides in their garden and green spaces to remove unwanted plants but these can hurt butterflies. Do you know any other ways to remove unwanted plants instead of using these?
