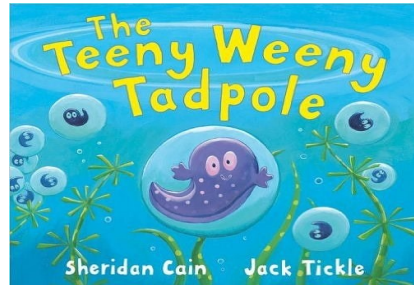
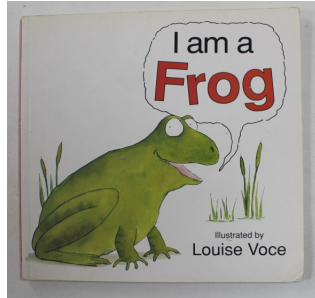
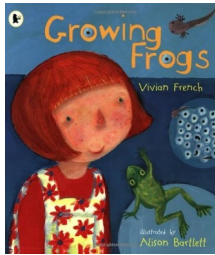
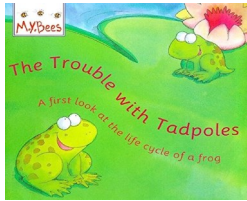
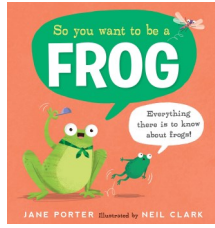
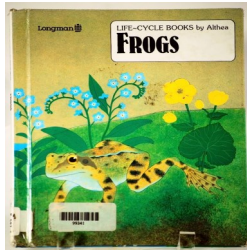
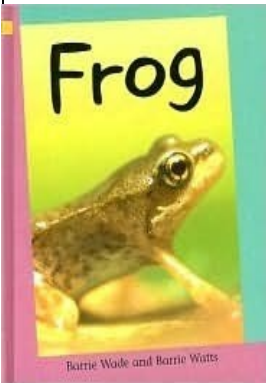
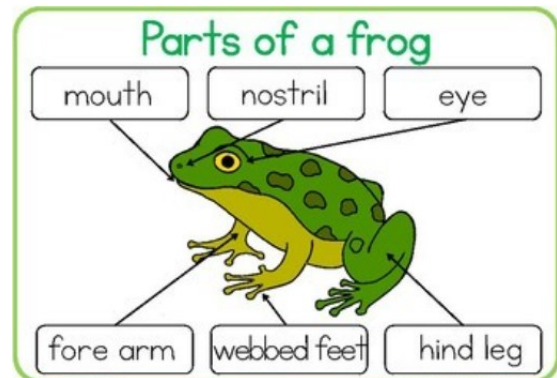
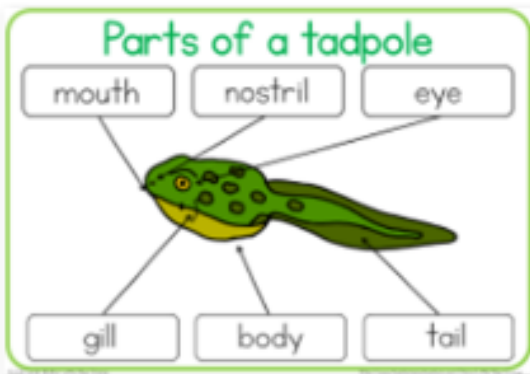


FS2 Knowledge Organiser- Frogs
